STUDENT ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL

Attendance from students should be as per the above tables. Where a student is unable to attend either online learning or face to face lessons due to illness or other reasons, parents must contact the College following the usual procedure.

If parents choose not to send their son to school due to a pre-determined health condition, please contact your son's Year Coordinator to ensure that continuity of learning can be arranged.

HEALTH AND HYGIENE

In order to maintain a safe and hygienic environment for all, the College has staggered the return to school and we have extended the extensive cleaning and sanitising practices of school facilities. We will be insisting on hygienic behaviours from all student upon their return.

We will emphasise with students the need to follow personal hygiene practices outlined below:

- regularly wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or using hand sanitiser, (dispensers are now located in high traffic areas,) at regular intervals throughout the day, particularly before and after eating, and after going to the toilet;
- cover coughs and sneezes with one's elbow or a tissue;
- place used tissues straight into the bin;
- avoid touching one's eyes, nose and mouth and face.

Student Areas

We also have included a range of further hygiene practices for the students such as:

- cleaning and sanitising classrooms every night;
- cleaning and sanitising of the student playground areas including toilets and lunch tables;
- increasing the amount of fresh air by opening classroom windows and doors where possible;
- all student bubblers and water fountains have been decommissioned. Students are required to bring their own water bottles to school or purchase water from the canteen;
- ensuring the 'hands off' rule with other students;
- students must not share food or drink.

SOCIAL DISTANCING IN SCHOOLS

Prime Minister Scott Morrison and the NSW Government have made it very clear that the 1.5m and 4m² social distancing rules do not apply in schools but we are emphasising good personal distancing. In classrooms we will keep students at a reasonable separation.

The staff areas are following very high hygienic and health practices appropriate to our workplace.

STUDENT UNIFORM

Students need to wear full winter school uniform when attending classes face to face from Week 3.

PARENTS AND VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL

Parents and visitors to the school will be discouraged. However the Uniform Shop will need to remain open. Volunteer parents in the canteen are still most necessary. All parents and visitors will be asked to use hand sanitisers on arrival.

At the end of each school day, we will assist parents waiting outside the school by placing social distance markers on the pavement.

SPORT

During Term 2 there is no interschool ISA or IPSHA competition sport. As the term progresses, consideration will be given to resuming training.

The Sarto Gym remains closed to student and staff use.

MUSIC TUTION AND ENSEMBLES

From Week 3 Music tuition will continue in a mix of online and face to face instruction on the days when students are in attendance.

The Ensemble Program will recommence from Week 4 in a modified format as the students return to the College. **COVIDSAFE APP**

The Government is encouraging all of us to download the COVIDSAFE APP. I have done so and encourage others to do the same. It is intended to help identify hotspots and enable a quick response. I understand the reservations some have due to privacy reasons and it is a personal decision.

CONCLUSION

The staff are looking forward to welcoming the students back with great anticipation and the students are very excited to be able to return to school in the near future.
