Future Dismissal Plan in the Event of a Positive Covid-19 Result

Please find below the Dismissal Plan that the College will implement in the case of a positive Covid-19 test result within the College.

If St Pius X College receives notification that a member of the school community has received a positive COVID-19 test result, the College will implement its COVID-19 Dismissal Plan. All students will be dismissed and asked to make their way directly home. Students who are unable to make their way home immediately will be supervised at the College until the end of the day, if requested by Parent/Carer by ringing Student Reception on 9411 4733.

St Pius X College will be in direct contact with NSW Health and will follow all protocols and advice that is given. Parents will be asked to keep all students at home and self-isolate whilst awaiting further information and advice from St Pius X College and/or NSW Health.

Please ensure that your son is aware of how you wish him to travel home. If he is to be picked up from the College, the following table shows pick up locations for each year group.

Parents are asked:

- Arrive no earlier than your son's designated time for Pick Up

- Online learning will commence on the first school day following the closure of the College and will continue until the campus can be deep cleaned and cleared to reopen. NSW Health will instruct the College when it can reopen.
