I write to give parents a further update regarding COVID-19 in the College.

Firstly, I thank all parents, students and staff for their vigilance in using the RAHT kits and testing before arriving at school every Monday and Thursday. Last Friday, the College issued every student with an additional 4 RAHT kits for use in Weeks 3 and 4.

Any students who were absent on Friday must collect their RAHT kits from the Student Reception Office and use these tests as soon as practical when entering the College.

I thank those parents who have notified the College of their son's positive result and also close contact to a household or family member. In each case the student has isolated as per the Public Health Orders.

POSITIVE CASES IN THE COLLEGE

As Week 3 begins today, 14 February 2022, I advise parents that today we have current positive cases in Year 7-11. Cases are particularly evident in Year 10 this week.

Parents are reminded that staff and students cannot attend school if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19. These include fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting, extreme tiredness, unexplained chest pain or conjunctivitis (eye infection).

Any positive results must be registered on the Service NSW App and the College must be notified immediately through stpiusx.nsw.edu.au

CLOSE CONTACTS

Parents are reminded that close contacts are only those people who live in the household of a person who has tested positive. A reminder that if anyone in your household tests positive, then your son will need to isolate for 7 days before coming back to school.

WORK FOR CLASSES
