The Class of 2021 had to face a particularly challenging year on a number of levels. They responded with great maturity and teamwork and consequently achieved high academic results as well as a powerful sense of community. They were a credit to their families and the College.

Congratulations to the College Dux, James Scaiff, with the excellent ATAR of 99.40. It was pleasing to see six students achieve an ATAR above 98 and over 25% of the cohort gaining ATARs above 90. Results were strong across all subjects. Overall, there were five boys in the Top All Rounders List.

Other results of particular note were that Max Leo, an accelerant student in Year 11 achieved First Place in New South Wales in Mathematics Advanced. In addition Thomas Cooper was ranked seventh in the state for Industrial Technology. These are wonderful achievements. A number of students were nominated for ENCORE and OnSTAGE in the Performing Arts, and another for SHAPE in Design and Technology.


